
MAKING OUR MARK

A BRIDGE TO SECONDARY EDUCATION

Middle School is an important transition between elementary school and high school. Students take content courses with content experts and are given the opportunity to study topics of personal interest on a deeper level.







Our students believe in themselves and in others. Grounded in the power of social and emotional development and under the guidance of content specialists and a caring counseling team, they engage in deep learning while embodying an authentic and meaningful community.

- Our students partner with The American Chemical Society, the National Institutes of Health, The Anacostia Riverkeeper Organization, and The Smithsonian National Air and Space Museum to bring science to life.
- Through partnerships with The Embassy Adoption Program, The Shakespeare Theater, The Kennedy Center, and Arena Stage, we make connections between the humanities curricula and the broader cultural landscape of our city, country, and world.
- Our students are fully immersed in the arts. They create pieces of unique work that promote self-expression. Through music instruction, each student has the opportunity to learn to play the piano and several other wind and percussion instruments.
- Our counseling program provides every eighth grade student one-on-one support, lending unprecendented guidance in their transition from middle school to high school.
